

Camper Code of Conduct

- 1. No abusive or foul language.
- 2. No Bullying. This includes, but is not limited to, name-calling, making threats, spreading rumors, excluding someone from activities, hitting/kicking/pinching, and taking or breaking someone's things.
- 3. No smoking, vaping, or tobacco use of any type. No use of alcohol or drugs. Weapons are not to used or shown during virtual camp.
- 4. No obscene or inappropriate sharing of images, videos or content.
- 5. Listen to counselors and staff. Be respectful and pay attention.
- 6. Be respectful of the rights, privacy and property of others.
- 7. Take care of and return all camp equipment.
- 8. Dress appropriately for recreational purposes.
- 9. Abide by all local, state and federal laws.

If the camper displays disruptive or harmful behavior, every effort will be made to address the behavior and to work with the camper. If the camper's behavior does not change after counseling, support, and a phone call to his or her parents, it will result in the camper being discharged from camp. Campers who are discharged due to behavior issues will not be invited back the following year and possibly permanently.
